Call for applications: Heritage Field School 2021

After postponing our physical event last year and hosting the alternative online programme because of the COVID-19 pandemic, we are excited to announce that this year our next event will take place upcoming October: **the Heritage Field School.**

The Heritage Field School will take place in the Netherlands from the 8th-11th of October 2021. The programme will include international case studies from all over Europe. These case studies will be presented in 4 different theme tracks:


- Heritage & Tourism
- Heritage & Inclusion
- Heritage & Repurposing
- Heritage & Climate Change

During the programme, we will explore ways to strengthen our Europe-wide network of young heritage professionals, students and volunteers, as well as to create an international exchange of knowledge, experience and ideas. We hope to do this via discussions, workshops, excursions and capacity building sessions.

What is The Future is Heritage?

The Future is Heritage is an international network and platform that aims to strengthen the position of young people working or volunteering in the heritage field throughout Europe. Together with partners, we are building our network and platform since 2018 through organising annual events, such as The Future is Heritage in Berlin in 2018 and the Capacity Building Days in Athens in 2019. In 2020 we scheduled the Heritage Field School, but unfortunately, because of the COVID-19 pandemic, we had to postpone the event till 2021. As an alternative, we hosted The Future is Heritage online programme, consisting of 5 webinars that introduced our main themes for the upcoming Heritage Field School.

Our goal is to work towards a more equal collaboration between young and established professionals within the European heritage field. Through our programmes and lobbying efforts, we aim to initiate international and intergenerational coöperation, dialogue and knowledge exchange in sustainable ways. By doing this, we hope to make it easier for young professionals, students and volunteers to enrich the European heritage sector with their knowledge, experience and creativity.

- The Netherlands (Arnhem-region).

- October 8-11th, 2021.

Travel:

- Participants are required to arrange their own travel to and from the event location.

Accommodation:

- Accommodation is provided.

Costs:

- A single contribution of €40 is asked.

Bursaries:

- Limited bursaries for travel expenses are available for those who need them. Please note in your application if you want to use one of the bursaries and why.

Participants:

- A limited amount of participants can be invited to participate in this event.

Eligibility

Who:

- Young people working in the heritage sector in Europe on a professional or voluntary basis or students with an interest or affinity with heritage in European heritage.

Age:

- 18-32 years old.

Affinity:

- You have a demonstrable affinity in your work/study/volunteering with the European heritage field.

Availability:

- Available for the entirety of the field school: October 8-11th 2021.
